FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Kia ora e te whānau. Ngā mihi o te Aweneti ki a koutou. Advent greetings to you all.

We started our week sharing karakia, and Hoiho chose to focus this week on Advent. The students from Hoiho shared with us some information about Advent, telling us that this was the first week of Advent. The students told us that Advent is a time to make preparations for the birth of Jesus, to get our hearts ready to welcome Jesus again at Christmas. One of the ways that we can prepare for the coming of Jesus is to be the Good News that Jesus proclaimed during his life on Earth - bringing the Reign of God in Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love. Showing kindness and being joyful are both great ways to prepare for Christmas.

The rest of my message is just a repeat of last week's message, drawing your attention to some special celebrations in the next 10 days or so. Please have another look through and plan to join us whenever you can. Lots of this information was also captured in a letter that was sent home earlier this week. Remember that **children will need to be collected at 12pm on the last day of school**.

You are all warmly invited to join us for the following celebrations:

- we will gather as a school community for the *Graduation and Prize Giving* for our Year 8 students on the evening of Monday 16 December at 5pm in the church, a whole school celebration focused on our graduating students for 2024, *followed by a whānau picnic and BBQ* in the school grounds;
- we will gather to celebrate the *Nativity* story, our Christmas story, on Friday 13 December starting at 2pm in the church.

Of course you are also all welcome to join us for the Year 8 Speeches on Monday 12 December at 5pm if you wish. All of these are really special opportunities to come together as a community and celebrate another fabulous year at St Joseph's School.
